

MINUTES

The Pine Bluff City Council met for a regular meeting at 5:30 p.m.

January 20, 2009 in the Council Chambers of City Hall.

Mayor Redus was absent

Alderwoman Holcomb acted as chairperson and called the meeting

to order.

The Invocation was given by Rev. Jesse Turner

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chairperson Holcomb.

Roll Call – Answering present were, Aldermen Brumett, Easterly,

Alderwoman Roberts, Alderman Stepps, Alderwoman Walker, Aldermen

Boyd and Brown.

Approval of Minutes – Alderwoman Roberts moved for approval

of the minutes from the January 5, 2009 meeting, seconded by Alderman

Brumett and the motion carried 7-0.

Alderwoman Holcomb, Chairperson of the Ordinances and

Resolutions Committee reported: Alderman Brumett will give the report

for this committee. Alderman Brumett reported, the committee met prior

to the Pine Bluff City Council meeting and recommended taking the following actions on the agenda:

Items No. 1 & 2 will be heard and completed

Alderman Brumett, Chairman of the Ways & Means Committee reported: the committee met prior to the meeting tonight and we have **four** budget adjustments that were in the packet and the first one is from the Transit Department and there is no method of financing required because they are moving funds from one account to another to balance the 2008 budget. Alderman Brumett moved for approval of the budget adjustment, seconded by Alderwoman Roberts and the motion carried 7-0.

The **second** budget adjustment is from the Street Department, again no new funds are required because funds are being moved from one line item to another to help balance the budget. Alderman Brumett moved for approval of the budget adjustment, seconded by Alderwoman Roberts and the motion carried 7-0.

The **third** budget adjustment is from the Community Development Department and you all should have gotten a copy in your packet. There are several line items where funds are being moved to help balance the 2008 year end budget. Alderman Brumett moved for approval of the

budget adjustment, seconded by Alderwoman Roberts and the motion carried 7-0.

The **fourth** budget adjustment is from the General Fund which included several departments, once again no additional funds are required because each department transferred funds to balance each department's budget. Alderman Brumett moved for approval of the budget adjustment, seconded by Alderwoman Roberts and the motion carried 7-0.

Alderman Brumett moved to **pay the bills** owed by the city, seconded by Alderwoman Roberts and the motion carried 7-0.

Alderwoman Roberts, Chairperson of Community Development Committee reported: the Pine Bluff Downtown Entertainment District Update report states in part: the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program has a matching grant program available for properties located in the commercial historic district for downtown Pine Bluff. Two Historic Preservation Restoration Grant options are available for rehabilitation of historic structures in Arkansas. Alderwoman Roberts stated a copy of this report is available to the public and will be filed in the City Clerk's office.
