PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS

1. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 22-24 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PINE BLUFF, ARKANSAS, *RESPECTING SIGNS* PROHIBITED IN ALL DISTRICTS AND RELATED PURPOSES **(up for the 3rd and final reading)**
2. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 29-138 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PINE BLUFF, ARKANSAS *RESPECTING REGULATIONS CONCERNING FENCES* **(up for the 3rd and final reading)**
3. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 26-113 IN CHAPTER 26 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PINE BLUFF, ARKANSAS, *RESPECTING PROHIBITED DRIVING ACTS, DESIGNATING USE OF FUNDS GENERATED BY CONVICTIONS FOR ENGAGING IN SUCH ACTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES* **(up for the 1st reading)**
